6. EDUCATIONAL PRESENTATIONS AND UPDATES

6.2 Policy Committee Update

Dr. Probst spoke about New York States upcoming law regarding cell phone restrictions in schools. The Committee has been discussing how to implement the new cell phone restrictions. The Committee is proposing the following by grade level:

- Elementary No cell phones, smartwatches or airpods in school.
- Middle School and High School No access to cell phones or smart devices during the school day. Cell phones stored in the students lockers or in locking pouches for the day.

Also under consideration are the consequences for students who do not abide with the restrictions once they are in place.
